EXTRACT of a LETTER from Mr THOMAS RANDOLPHE to Sir WILLIAM CECILL, dated Edenburgh, 18th April 1565.

THE cave found bysyds Muskelbourge semeth to be some monument of the Romaynes, by a stone that was found, wth these words greven upon hym. Apolloni GRANNO Q. L. SABINIANUS PROC. Aug. Dyvers short pillers sette upright upon the grounde, covered wth tyle stones, large and thyucke, torning into dyvers angles and certayne places lyke unto chynes* to awoid smoke. Thys is all that I cane gather therof.
