

4. CARVED STONE, TOMINTEOLD, NR. ABERFELDY.

A wedge-shaped stone which measures 1 ft. 4 ins. in height and has a maximum width of 1 ft. 2 ins. stands in the farmyard at Tominteold Farm, nearly 2 miles north-west of Aberfeldy, Perthshire (NN/828504). One face of the stone contains about a dozen cup-and-ring marks which have an average diameter of $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins., while on the other side of the stone a cross is roughly carved in relief (Pl. LXV a). The stone, which is of local schist, is said to have been found on the moor about a mile north of Tominteold a number of years ago.
