

APPENDIX B - The Historic Scotland Project Database

The list presented on microfiche is a version of the projects database, correct to 6 December 1995 (taking account of material published in volume 124 of PSAS, and submissions received by the Society to 30 November. There was space for only 7 of the data fields.

1. Project Name

2. LY = Last year of fieldwork.

3. PD = Publication date (see next page for meaning of codes).

4. Short Ref. = Short reference of substantial publication.

5. R = Local Authority Region, using the standard Scottish Office codes:

7. Short Project History = as yet incomplete project histories.

The coding in the **PUBLICATION DATE** field in the database is the important one for determining the status and future plans for a project:

a number (eg 95) shows the year of publication, if it has been published.

ar = 'archive'. Publication is not considered appropriate (eg for small casework-related surveys, or sites where the results of the work merit no more than has been published in <u>Discovery and Excavation in</u> <u>Scotland</u>.); or publication is not possible (eg through loss of primary data).

s = 'submitted'. The final report on the project has been submitted to a publication outlet. This is by no means the end of the process, as some journals may require significant revisions or may reject a paper.

f = 'first full draft'. This means that Historic Scotland has received a first full draft of the project report. The difference between a report being at first full draft and being submitted is one of the most significant factors in the nature and cause of the backlog in Scotland. 0 = 'unpublished'. There is a presumption that a publication will be completed.

**?p** = 'possible publication'. This is a holding category for projects where an appropriate publication outlet is still being sought, or for new projects whose publication status has not yet been determined, and for older projects, where an assessment of the desirability or possibility of publication (eg is there enough archive surviving?) has still to be assessed. 86% of the projects in this category are small urban trial excavations and watching briefs, which are a particular problem.
