

PRELIMINARY LIST OF SCULPTURED STONES OLDER THAN A.D. 1100,  
WITH SYMBOLS AND CELTIC ORNAMENT, IN SCOTLAND.

(Compiled by J. Romilly Allen, F.S.A. Scot.)

In the following List are included three classes of monuments—(1) boulders, slabs, or pillars with symbols incised; (2) crosses, cross-slabs, or recumbent coped stones, with symbols and Celtic ornament sculptured in relief; and (3) crosses, cross-slabs, or recumbent coped stones, with Celtic ornament sculptured in relief, but without symbols.

The List is arranged in counties, which are grouped geographically, and the localities in each county are arranged alphabetically. The name of the locality placed first is that by which the stone has previously been distinguished in Dr Stuart's *Sculptured Stones of Scotland*, or in the *Proceedings of the Society of Antiquaries of Scotland*. This is done to prevent unnecessary confusion. The locality placed first is generally (although not always) the one from which the stone came originally, and its present position is given afterwards.

The Council of the Society of Antiquaries of Scotland having decided to devote the funds of the Gunning Fellowship for the next two years to the preparation of a complete descriptive Catalogue of the Early Sculptured Stones of Scotland, the present short List is issued as a

necessary preliminary. The particulars now given are only intended to be sufficient to identify the various localities where the stones occur. The fuller Catalogue will embody the results of an archæological survey of the Christian Monuments of Scotland older than A.D. 1100, and will contain a technical description of the ornament on each stone, together with all other information that can be collected with regard to it. The same arrangement will be adhered to in the complete Catalogue as in the Preliminary List, and the survey will be made in sections in the same manner.

The object the Council of the Society has in view in circulating the present List, is to obtain information about new stones not as yet known to archæologists, and about stones included in the List that have been lost, moved, or destroyed.

It is therefore requested that persons who receive this List will show it to everyone likely to be in a position to make additions or corrections. All communications on the subject should be sent to the Secretary, Society of Antiquaries of Scotland, Queen Street, Edinburgh.
